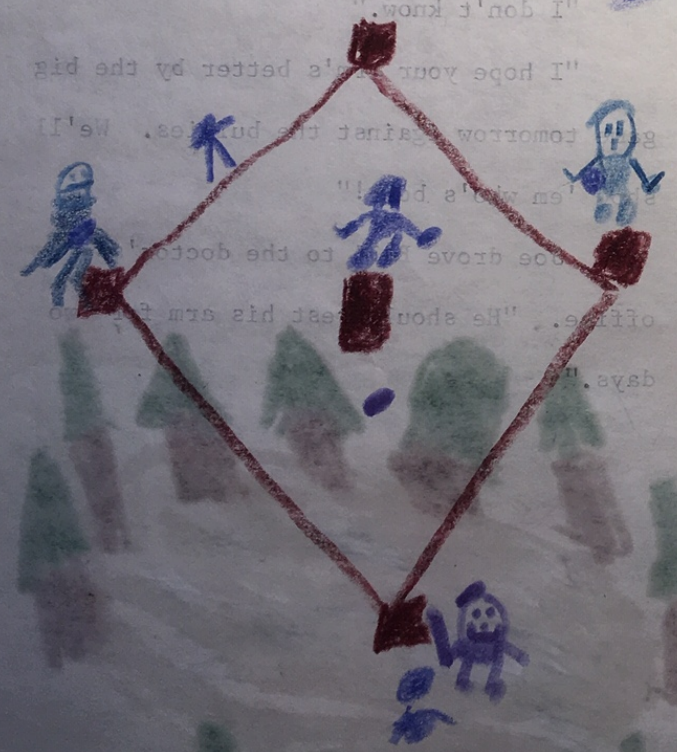
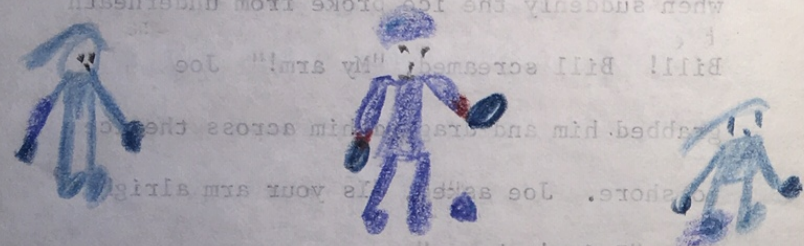
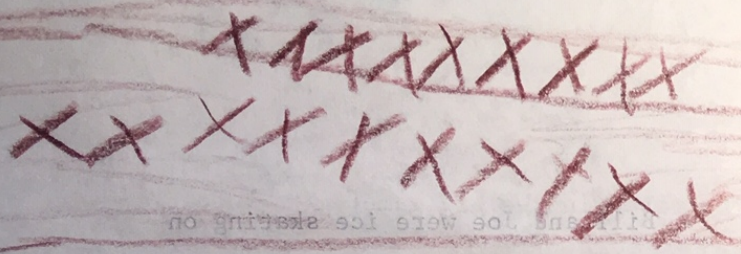
Bill and Joe were ice skating on

him out and put in a relief pitcher. They

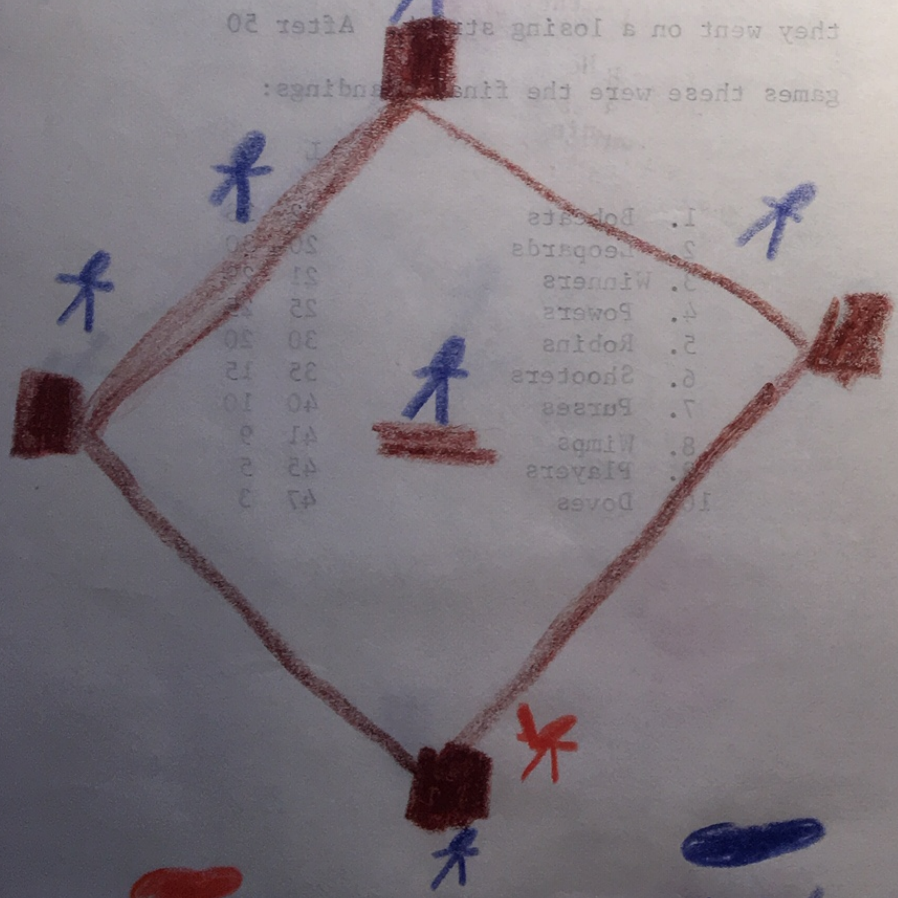
won 1 - 0.

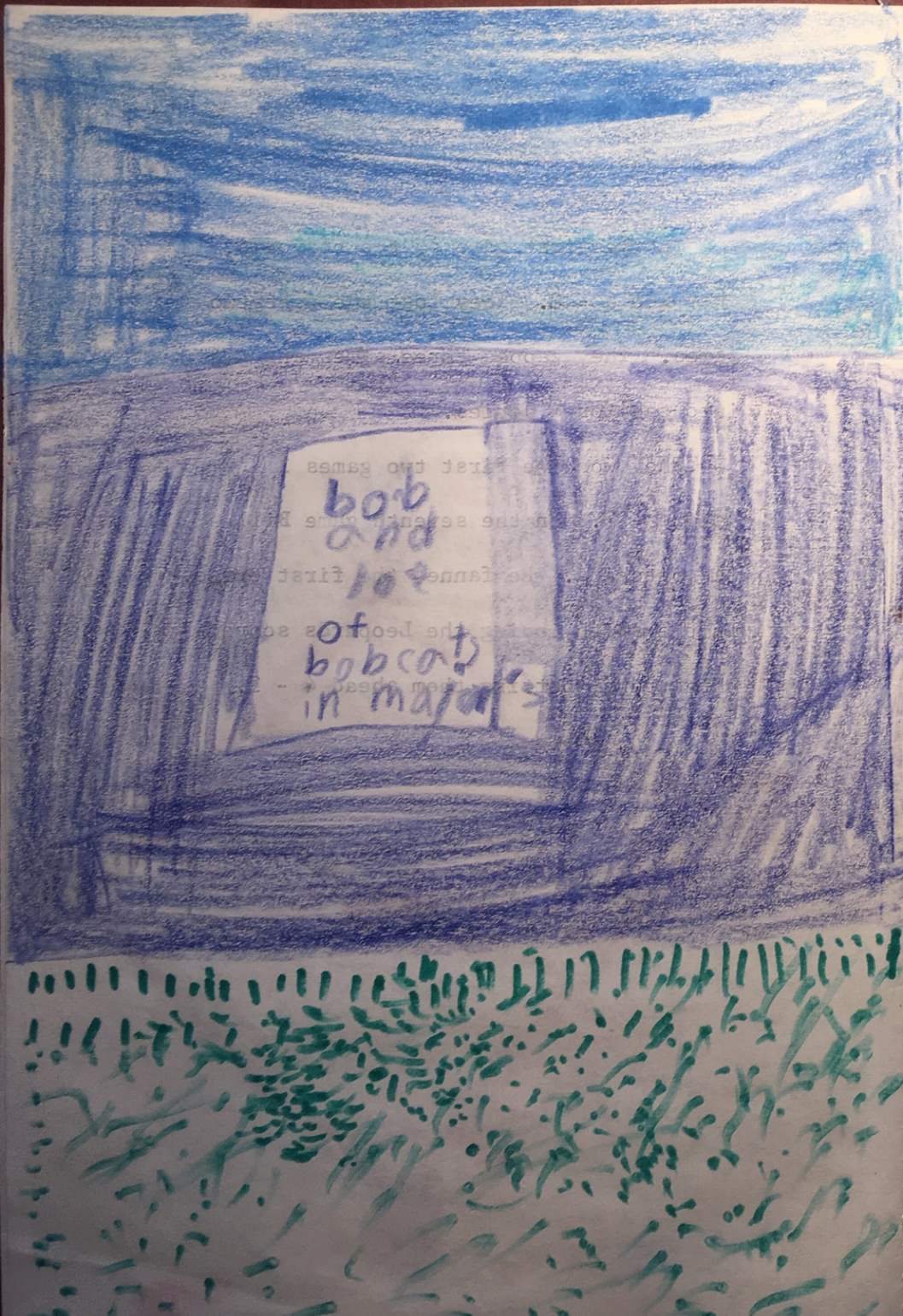
